In addition to housing, PSBU offers essential on-campus services, including an **on-site medical clinic**. This clinic provides healthcare services to students, helping them maintain their physical well-being and reducing any potential medical costs that could act as a financial burden, especially for low-income families.

Furthermore, PSBU has an **on-campus cafeteria** that provides affordable meals, ensuring that students can access nutritious food at low costs. This setup not only fosters a healthy living environment but also relieves the financial pressure of food expenses, allowing students to focus on their studies without worrying about basic needs.

These comprehensive support services, including housing, healthcare, and access to affordable food, enable students from disadvantaged backgrounds to live on campus and pursue their education in a stable, supportive environment. PSBU's efforts contribute to its commitment to **SDG 1: No Poverty**, helping students from low-income families overcome barriers to education.
