**Cheating Policy**

**Policy owner:** Academic Board

**1. Purpose**

To outline what constitutes cheating in examinations and assessments and how PSBU responds to it.

**2. Scope**

Applies to all forms of assessment, including written, oral, practical, and online formats.

**3. Definition**

Cheating is any dishonest act intended to gain unfair academic advantage. Examples include:

- Using unauthorised materials in an examination.
- Copying from or communicating with another candidate.
- Impersonating another student.
- Submitting falsified or fabricated data.
- Using generative AI or translation software to produce unacknowledged content.

**4. Procedures**

- Invigilators or assessors must report suspected cases immediately.
- The Registrar's Office logs all reports for investigation.
- Students will be notified in writing and invited to respond to allegations.
- The Faculty Integrity Panel reviews evidence and determines outcomes.

**5. Education and Prevention**

- Students receive training on proper examination conduct and digital ethics.
- Clear exam regulations are published each semester.
