Ethos Universitas – Seal Usage Guidelines

1. Purpose

The Ethos Universitas Seal is the official visual identifier of Ethos Universitas. It represents the principles of integrity, academic responsibility, and international cooperation.

2. Authorised Use

The seal may be used exclusively by:

- Registered Institutions of Ethos Universitas, and
- Individuals recognised as Honorary Companions (institutional leadership)

3. Visual Integrity and Approved Versions

The seal must always be used in its original form. It may not be altered, recoloured, distorted, combined with other logos or used as a partial or decorative element. To ensure consistency, the seal is provided in three standard versions:

- Full colour (navy) → for light backgrounds
- Black → for monochrome use
- White → for dark backgrounds

4. Background Use

The seal must be placed on a clear and neutral background. Use colour or black on light backgrounds. Use white on dark backgrounds. Avoid textured or low-contrast backgrounds.

5. Size and Clarity

The seal must always remain clearly legible. Sufficient clear space must be maintained around the seal. Minimum size: Print: 25 mm width / Digital: 150 px width

6. File Formats

The official seal is provided in the following formats:

- PNG (transparent background – standard use)
- SVG (vector format – printing and scaling)

7. Distribution

The official seal package is provided by the PCU Committee to authorised recipients.

8. Rights

The Ethos Universitas Seal remains the intellectual property of Panathlon International. Its use is limited to authorised institutions and recognised individuals.

PREAH SIHAMONIRAJA BUDDHIST UNIVERSITY HOLDS ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMS FOR THE 2026-2027 ACADEMIC YEAR

On the morning of April 26, 2026, Preah Sihamoniraja Buddhist University organized an entrance examination to select monastic and lay students for enrollment in its Master's degree programs for the 2026–2027 academic year. The ceremony was held under the high presidency of His Excellency Ngoun Sdechpheapdey; Advisor to Samdech Moha Borvor Thipadei Hun Manet, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia, and Secretary of State of the Ministry of Cult and Religion, representing His Holiness Supreme Patriarch Bour Kry, the Rector of Preah Sihamoniraja Buddhist University. The event was also attended by Her Excellency Touch Sarom, Secretary of State and high representative of His Excellency Dr. Chay Borin, Minister of Cult and Religion; His Excellency Lao Chhiv Eav, Undersecretary of State and high representative of His Excellency Academician Dr. Hang Chuon Naron, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Education, Youth and Sports; and Most Venerable Samdech Preah Rotanaktrairatavongsochar Sok Bunthoeun, Dean of the Faculty of Philosophy, Religion, and Law. Also present were members of the management board, professors, academic staff, and approximately 615 registered exam candidates.

Speaking at the event, His Excellency Ngoun Sdechpheapdey expressed a firm commitment to solidarity in elevating Buddhist higher education at Preah Sihamoniraja Buddhist University. He emphasized the continuous mission to build and develop robust human resources capable of serving as valuable pillars for both secular and religious sectors in national society. His Excellency detailed that a total of 615 monastic and lay candidates sat for the entrance exam across seven distinct specialties. This cohort includes 250 candidates for Public Administration (Generation 22), 125 for Private Law (Generation 6), 80 for General Management (Generation 9), 55 for Educational Sciences (Generation 11), 30 for Teaching English as a Foreign Language (Generation 11), 30 for Khmer Literature (Generation 6), and 45 for Buddhist Philosophy (Generation 2). These enrollment figures reflect the university's active commitment to contributing to the Royal Government's Pentagonal Strategy-Phase I, which prioritizes human capital development.

Furthermore, the representative from the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports commended and thanked Preah Sihamoniraja Buddhist University for its dedication to enhancing educational quality. He noted that this entrance examination serves as a standard to measure the true capabilities of scholars, wishing all applicants success in their exams. Concurrently, the representative from the Ministry of Cult and Religion expressed full support for the university's human resource development mission, which aims to guide youth to attain both advanced knowledge and strong moral virtue to contribute effectively to the country's development. Following the opening remarks, the presiding dignitaries, university management, and faculty members jointly unsealed the examination papers for the Master's degree entrance test, concluding the official opening with a commemorative group photograph.

PREAH SIHAMONIRAJA BUDDHIST UNIVERSITY STUDENTS ATTEND SEMINAR ON "THE ROLE OF THE INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSOCIATION OF CAMBODIA AND ALTERNATIVE AND JUDICIAL DISPUTE RESOLUTION MECHANISMS" AT THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE

On Wednesday, April 29, 2026, students from Preah Sihamoniraja Buddhist University attended a seminar on "The Role of the Intellectual Property Association of Cambodia and Alternative and Judicial Dispute Resolution Mechanisms." The event was presided over by Her Excellency So Srymich, Secretary of State of the Ministry of Commerce and high representative of Her Excellency Cham Nimul, Minister of Commerce. The seminar featured distinguished guest speakers including His Excellency Oum Ratana, President of the Intellectual Property Association of Cambodia; His Excellency Leav Piseth, Deputy Secretary-General of the General Secretariat of the National Authority for Alternative Dispute Resolution; Mr. San Bunthoeun, Judge of the Phnom Penh Municipal Court; and His Excellency Pech Ang and His Excellency Kang Daravuth, former Presidents of the Intellectual Property Association of Cambodia. The session was moderated by Attorney Pech Sela, Vice President of the Intellectual Property Association of Cambodia, at the Ministry of Commerce headquarters.

Through their participation in this seminar, the students of Preah Sihamoniraja Buddhist University gained vital insights into the "Role of the Intellectual Property Association." The association serves as an essential bridge connecting creators,



business owners, and government institutions to ensure respect for intellectual property rights and to protect the legitimate interests of rights holders. Additionally, the association plays a key role in disseminating knowledge, providing consultancy, and facilitating the mediation of intellectual property disputes. Following the presentations, a Q&A session was organized, allowing students and attendees to ask questions and engage in discussions with the speakers to further broaden their understanding of the topic. The students' participation in this program provided them with crucial knowledge regarding intellectual property and dispute resolution mechanisms; practical insights that can be applied to both their academic pursuits and future careers. Ultimately, this seminar contributed to raising legal awareness and fostering human resource development to ensure capacity and competitiveness in modern society.

Fourth, regular collaborative meetings must be reinforced monthly, quarterly, semi-annually, and nine-monthly across all offices and departments. 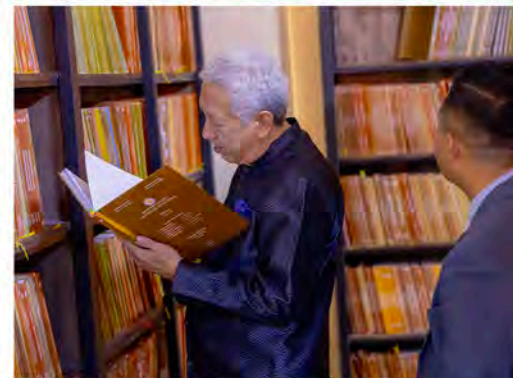

"UNIVERSITIES IN BUDDHIST MONASTERIES: FROM THE ANCIENT ANGKOR ERA TO THE AGE OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE"

On the morning of May 15, 2026, Preah Sihamoniraja Buddhist University organized a special lecture titled "Universities in Buddhist Monasteries: From the Ancient Angkor Era to the Age of Artificial Intelligence." The distinguished lecture was delivered by Senior Minister Professor Chhem Kieth Rethy, Chairman of the Economic, Social, and Cultural Council. The event was held under the high presidency of His Excellency Ngoun Sdechpheakdey, Personal Advisor to Samdech Moha Borvor Thipadei Hun Manet, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia, and Secretary of State of the Ministry of Cult and Religion in charge of Preah Sihamoniraja Buddhist University; on behalf of His Holiness Samdech Preah Mahasangharajah Dhipati Bour Kry, the Rector of the university. The gathering was also attended by His Excellency Chhem Phalla, Vice Chairman of the Economic, Social, and Cultural Council; His Excellency Khieng Sothy, Technical Advisor to the Council; alongside university management, monastic officials, civil servants, staff, professors, and approximately 400 monastic and lay students at the Peace Palace Hall on the 3rd floor.

Delivered by Senior Minister Professor Chhem Kieth Rethy, the lecture aimed to elevate the role of Buddhist education in the academic sector by re-examining the ancient Angkorian Buddhist universities as centers of multidisciplinary studies, ethics, and social foundation-building. Drawing from the concept of Prajnaparamita; or the attainment of perfected wisdom; the educational model of the Angkor era offers a profound visionary framework for restructuring modern universities in the age of artificial intelligence. In his opening remarks, His Excellency Ngoun Sdechpheakdey stated that this lecture opens a new page in scientific and philosophical research with its deep and transitional theme. He emphasized that in this transitional era, education must be a process that refines "information" into "wisdom." While artificial intelligence (AI) technologies display immense capabilities in data calculation and analysis, human virtue, compassion, and conscience are increasingly vital to direct these technologies toward serving the common good.

During his presentation, Professor Chhem Kieth Rethy outlined five core objectives of the lecture: (1) to present Angkor as a civilization of science and wisdom; (2) to demonstrate how wisdom was structured institutionally through ashrams and Buddhist universities; (3) to derive key fundamental principles where wisdom must precede information and ethics must precede technical execution; (4) to compare these historical foundations with modern educational systems and AI-driven intelligence, which lacks inherent human wisdom; and (5) to propose a vision for future universities that reconnects AI technology with ethics and responsibility toward humanity. Concurrently, he advised all monastic and lay students not to rely entirely on AI as an absolute guide or teacher, cautioning that artificial intelligence lacks the human reason, conscience, and morality required to prevent negative impacts on individuals, society, and the world at large.

Following the lecture, a vibrant and active Q&A session took place, fostering a dynamic exchange of ideas to further deepen and broaden the discussed topics. Through the thought-provoking inquiries of the participants and the comprehensive responses from the Senior Minister, the attending monastic and lay students gained valuable new knowledge, experiences, and perspectives perfectly aligned with the continuous evolution of digital technology in modern society.

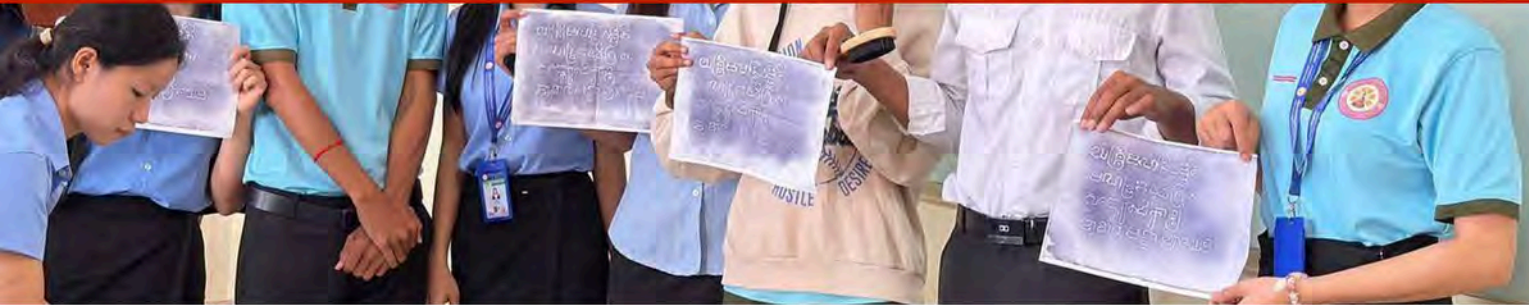

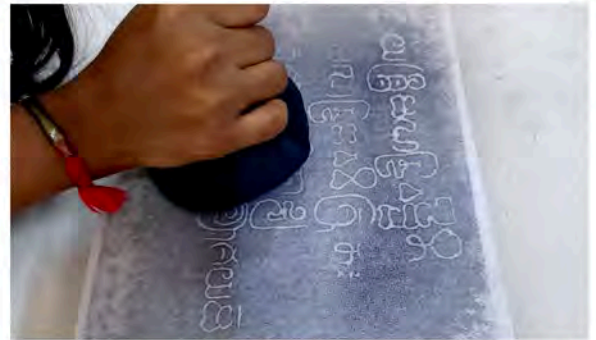
